Sunday School & Kings Club

We currently have two groups, one for children aged from 3 to 7 (Sunday School) and one for children aged between 7 and 11 (Kings Club). Both groups use various activities to help the children to learn more about God and what it means to be a friend of Jesus.

Sunday school and King's Club have joined together this term (while the church hall has been out of action) to learn about Gideon in parallel with the rest of the church. This is being followed with the stories of Boaz and Ruth, and their great grandson David, as we see God's provision of a godly king for Israel who points to The King, Jesus. We have enjoyed seeing how God can work in the lives of ordinary people who trust Him.

While the number of children varies, both groups can have up to six or seven children. In terms of the adults who are involved we have a core team who are involved most weeks, we have some occasional helps, plus those who help out during the summer holidays.
